Requirements

- Statement Of Purpose / Letter Of Intent / Statement Of Interest (1-2 pg.)
- Recommendation Letters (atleast 3)
- Transcripts from ALL post secondary schools / Provisional Degree
- Resume / CV
- Application Fee Payment
- To apply for scholarships/assistantships you will need to write a proposal.
 - They can be need-based or merit-based depending on the type of scholarship being offered
 - There is State funded, Institutional, Out-of-state etc. scholarships and discounts available for students

- Additional requirement for International Students
 - After receiving your i20 you need to pay your I-901 SEVIS fee (<u>https://www.ice.gov/sevis/i901</u>)
 - Score Cards of (GRE , TOEFL, IELTS, LSAT, GMAT etc..)



Statement of Purpose

- A statement of purpose (SOP), in the context of applying for graduate school, is an essay that's one of the most important aspects of your application because it tells the admission committee WHO you are, WHY you're applying, why you're a good candidate, and WHAT you want to do in the future.
- Things you should note while writing a Statement Of Purpose
 - Try to fit the SOP in atmost 2 pages (ideal : 1 pg.)
 - Don't copy paste your SOP (*Plagiarism*)
 - Read 2-3 sample SOPs that are *available publicly* before drafting yours.
 - Be genuine
 - Ask others to read your SOP and provide feedback
 - Go through your SOP again and again and make necessary changes until you think you're satisfied.

Letter Of Recommendation


- You'll need **atleast 3** letters of recommendation for applying to graduate school.
- You can ask your professors, Head of Department, Dean, Director whomsoever you're comfortable with to write you a letter of recommendation.
- Try to get these as soon as possible since professors are a lot busy with their work.
- Be professional while asking for recommendation
 - You can include details like deadline of application, no. of programs you're applying to etc.

Few Tips...

- Start working on your application EARLY (maybe 2-3 months BEFORE the deadline)
- Make sure you follow and complete all the requirements set by the program (i.e., required documents, score cards, formatting style)
 - Your application can be easily rejected on technicalities so pay attention to what is required.
 - Improper formatting.
- Make sure you follow up on your application. It is YOUR responsibility to ensure that all the documents (SOP, LOR, etc.) reach the appropriate office in advance of the deadline
